Our strategy:

We are committed to monitoring, managing, and reducing the overall negative impacts of our operations, while maximising the beneficial impacts of our business and products on the world.

Our key focus is on climate mitigation and adaptation, so we are able to deliver on our purpose effectively.

About Accsys:

We are a fast growing business with a purpose. We combine chemistry, technology and ingenuity to make high performance wood products that are extremely durable and stable, opening new opportunities for the built environment.

We recognise that climate change is one of the biggest challenges that we are all facing and seek to meet the challenge through our products and activities.

Our commitments:

People and culture

Embedding sustainability principles into our organisation: we will look to enable our people to implement the Climate Change Policy though engagement, initiatives such as our Green Champions Network, and training for relevant employees.

Managing the impacts of our manufacturing processes and offices

- **Energy efficiency:** we will focus on increasing efficiencies in operations where possible, which can include a focus on equipment, processes, facilities, etc.
- Green energy and fuel switching (on and off-site): we will use green energy and monitor opportunities to switch to lower emission sources where possible.
- Other resource use: we will focus on reducing water, waste, and other activities (e.g., thirdparty disposal and treatment), as these activities also have associated emissions.
- Design of new sites: we will incorporate sustainable site design in construction and for everyday operation.
- Offices: we will also look to reduce the environmental impact related to our offices where possible.

Supporting our partners and wider society through climate action

- Value chain focus: we will seek to understand and ultimately address scope 3 greenhouse gas emissions (our indirect impacts). Scope 3 emissions can include:
 - Further embedding sustainability into procurement processes, for example, only using certified sustainable wood to produce our products.
 - Emissions associated with our construction activities and contractors.
 - Emissions associated with raw materials and products (including logistics).
 - Business travel.



 Advocacy, value chain engagement and reduction: we will engage with our key stakeholders on climate related issues to drive climate action across the value chain, which includes stakeholders, such as our customers, suppliers, business partners, industry contacts, etc.

TCFD (the Task Force on Climate Related Financial Disclosures)

- **Understanding climate risk and opportunities:** we will use the TCFD (the Task Force on Climate Related Financial Disclosures) Framework to understand, support and manage climate risk and resilience in relation to our business.
- Acting on climate risk and opportunities: we will ensure that our activities take into consideration physical and transitional risks and opportunities to ensure robust financial and strategic planning.

Monitoring performance

• Continuous improvement of systems to assess and monitor data accuracy: we will continuously assess and improve our data management and monitoring systems to ensure accuracy of our data, as well as use credible external benchmarks and certification schemes to understand, improve, and report performance.

Sustainable products

• Contribution of Accsys' products to a transition to the net zero economy: we will continue to offer products which contribute towards global efforts to a net zero economy through carbon sequestration, circular economy principles and substitution of higher carbon impact materials in the built environment.
